Stand Chaperone

When you arrive, please help to set up the bleacher area for the band. The second section of stadium bleachers (next to the maroon and gold painted seats) is reserved for the band during each football game. This area needs to be blocked off with Caution Tape. There is a large roll of the Caution Tape on the shelf in the band room closet. In the Rubbermaid drawers in the back of the band closet is a drawer that contains scissors and tape. Tie or tape the Caution Tape up at the top of the section and down along each side. Also run the Caution Tape across the front of the section and tie or tape onto the stair railings.

The students will also need water during the game. The Lock In Meal volunteers will leave the large water tank with sprayers (already filled with water) right outside the band room doors on the sidewalk. Please refill as needed and wheel it into the stadium and park it in front of the band section. No cups are needed; the students will have water bottles for filling. You will also want to get a trash bag from the band room closet to tie onto the water cooler for any trash the students might have during the game. If the large water tank is unavailable (broke) the large orange water cooler will be used.

As the students march onto the field, you can take a seat in the band section of the bleachers. Once they march off the field and up into the bleachers, please remove the front strip of Caution Tape so they can get to their seats. You can replace the front strip of Caution Tape at half time to block off the seats while the students are performing on the field.

During the game you will need to stay in the student section in case the students need anything.

When the game is over and the students have left the bleachers, make sure all the trash has been cleaned up in our section. You can throw out the bag of trash attached to the water cooler. Please drain the water cooler of any left over water and wheel it back to the uniform room for storage. Remove the top lid to let it air dry over night.

First Aid Chaperone Volunteers

When you arrive, please help the Stand Chaperone set up the bleacher area for the band. Get the medical bag from the band closet to take with you to the bleachers. It can be found on the shelf on the right side of the band closet.

Once the band gets ready to head to the field, take the medical bag and go to the band section of the bleachers. Assist the Stand Chaperone with removing the front strip of Caution Tape when the band marches up from the field into the bleachers.

During the game you will need to stay in the student section in case the students need anything. The medical bag is equipped with break and squeeze ice packs, Band Aids and many other first aid supplies. Please familiarize yourself with its contents. We also carry Tylenol in the bag as well as additional medication for several other students, which can only be dispensed by a staff member. There is a sheet in the bag with the student's names and whether or not they're allowed to take Tylenol. Please refer to that first and be sure to log the student's name, date and time on the log in the front zipper of the bag.

When the students leave the stands to perform the half time show, go with them and take the medical bag. While they perform stay just off the field with the Pit Crew volunteers and then follow the students back to the bleachers when the show is over.

When the game is over and the students have left the bleachers, help the Stand Chaperone make sure all the trash has been cleaned up in our section and the water cooler is drained and taken back to the band room closet. Please write any items that have been used from the bag on the pad of paper in the front pocket. When you're finished, put the medical bag back on the shelf in the band room closet as well. **THANK YOU!!**
