We need parent volunteers to make this program happen! Opportunities include...

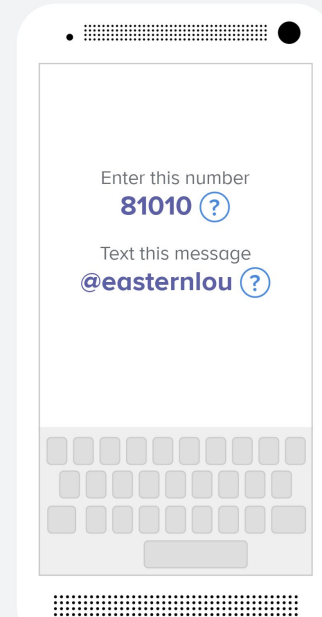
- Competition transportation
